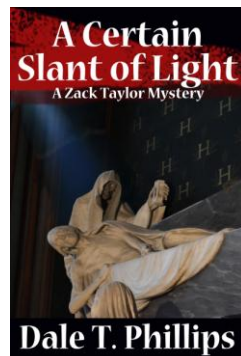

New Releases

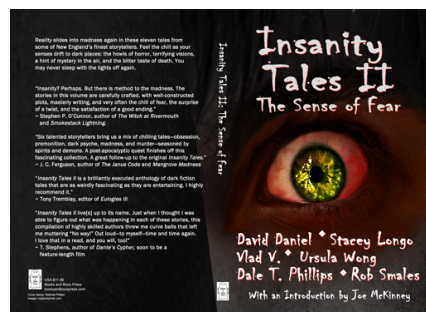
To show how busy things have been, I've got THREE new books out! Time to stock up on good reading for the long winter months ahead.
